

Concerns and Complaints Summary

Staff at Pixmore aim to work closely with parents/carers and we hope that any who have any concerns or anxieties will, in the first instance, raise these with the class teacher or head teacher. If you are not sure whom to approach, please ask your child's class teacher (or get in touch with the school office). We find that nearly all concerns or potential complaints can be resolved happily through discussion.

The governors of the school do have arrangements for considering complaints formally. For general complaints and matters to do with special educational needs they have adopted a procedure which follows guidelines recommended by Hertfordshire County Council.
