



AMAZING AMERICAS

Research the capital cities of all the countries in North and South America. Make a quiz/song/game to help people learn them.

Research and write a biography of a famous person from North America e.g. a president, actor, historic figure.

Choose a state in the USA and create a fact file describing it.

Consider:

How it got its name?

What the state capital, flag and symbol is?

How many people live there?

What the major big cities are in the state?

What is the terrain (landscape) like? E.g. mountains, desert etc.



Create a PowerPoint presentation or poster about famous American landmarks. Include pictures and information about them.

Make a holiday brochure page for a trip to a country in North or South America. Remember to be persuasive and include information about the human and physical things you can see. Remember to include pictures and make it bright and colourful to attract the reader's attention.



Find out about different animals that live in the Amazon rainforest.

Present your findings in an interesting way e.g. a David Attenborough TV show or a cuddly toy for a child to play with.

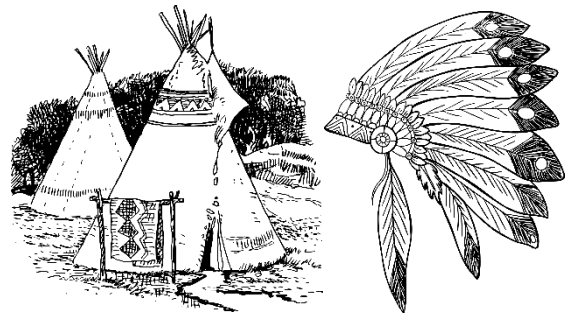
Make a 'Native American' model and write a label to go with it to explain what it is. You could make a totem pole, tepee, tomahawk or some Native American jewellery.

Explore draw and colour 4 different Native American tribal patterns.

Write a newspaper report about Christopher Columbus returning from his voyage to America. What did he discover? What struggles did he face? How does he feel about his discovery?

Research a Native American legend.

Create a storyboard, write a narrative recount or create an animation of the legend.



Research what living in Native American tribe (e.g. the Apache, Hopi or Navajo) would be like. Present your information in an interesting way e.g. a model or diary entry.

Include as much information as you can about your home, food and environment including the weather, terrain and the sorts of animals you come into contact with.

Surprise your teacher.

A homework task of your choice about North or South America. This is your chance to really amaze your teacher!
