Look at the images of Laurel Burch's work.

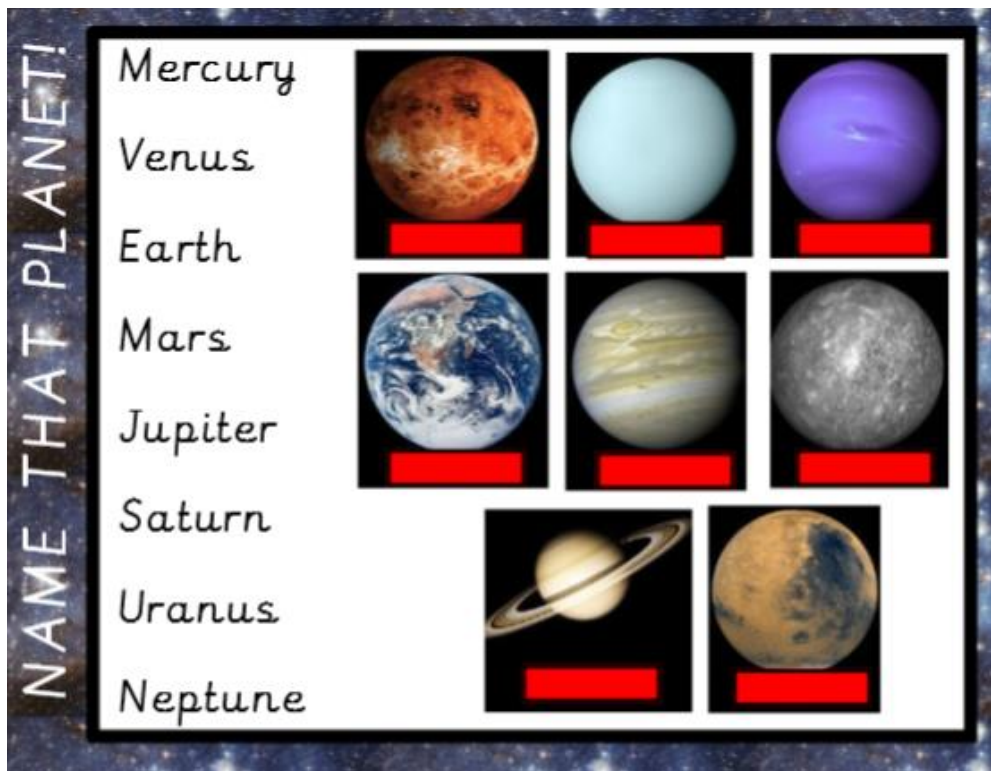
Annotate the images remembering to include your thoughts on

Geography
