

Sharks have rough skin and they cannot fold their fins. They have strong **jaws** (mouths) but flat **grinding** teeth. Sharks have a fantastic sense of smell so they can sniff out food from huge distances. There are about 350 types of shark; they include some of the largest fish in the world.
