3. Could the information be used in the introduction or one of your paragraphs?

4. Make notes using bullet points by changing/ trimming words and taking key bits of information.

Pyramids are the stone tombs of Egypt where Ancient Egyptians buried famous Pharaohs. They have stood for thousands of years filled with many hidden secrets that give clues about what life (and death) was like in Ancient Egypt.
